Eliminates automatic reporting of person found to have committed act that would constitute felony sex crime if committed by adult. Requires court to set hearing on issue of reporting prior to end of court or Psychiatric Security Review Board jurisdiction over person and sets criteria for ordering person to report.

Requires Department of Human Services to ensure that providers of care for wards in substitute care follow reasonable and prudent parent standard and that wards have regular, ongoing opportunities to engage in age-appropriate or developmentally appropriate activities. When court decides to continue child or ward in substitute care, requires court to make certain findings for ward 16 years of age or older with permanency plan of another planned permanent living arrangement. Requires that court review comprehensive plan for ward's transition to successful adulthood and make certain findings when ward is 14 years of age or older. Changes term "independent living" to "successful adulthood" in permanency plan hearings and determinations. Limits permanency placements in another planned permanent living arrangements to children or wards 16 years of age or older. Declares emergency, effective October 1, 2015.
