When court decides to continue child or ward in substitute care, requires court to make certain findings for ward 16 years of age or older with permanency plan of another planned permanent living arrangement. Requires that court review comprehensive plan for ward's transition to successful adulthood and make certain findings when ward is 14 years of age or older. Changes term "independent living" to "successful adulthood" in permanency plan hearings and determinations. Limits permanency placements in another planned permanent living arrangements to children or wards 16 years of age or older. Declares emergency, effective October 1, 2015.
