IACP Annual Conference Scholarship Application

The OACP is offering a \$2,000 scholarship to assist one (1) OACP Member to attend the annual IACP Conference. The scholarship will be awarded on a point-system basis described below. *Applicants will submit short narrative briefly explaining why they should be chosen and what benefits they will receive by attending the IACP Conference.* This narrative will be reviewed and scored by the OACP Scholarship Committee and used in determining the recipient of the scholarship.

The criteria for the scholarship are as follows:

Eligibility

- 1. Applicants must never have attended an IACP Annual Conference in the past.
- 2. Must be a member of the OACP in "Good Standing."
- 3. Preference will be given to Police Chiefs from a smaller agency (defined as 15 or fewer authorized sworn officer positions.

Scoring

Points will be assigned as follows:

1. One (1) point for each 5-years of service in law enforcement –AND– for each 5-years serving as a Police Chief. (Maximum 5 points for each)

Years of Service	In Law Enforcement	As a Police Chief
1 – 5	1 point	1 point
6 – 10	2 points	2 points
11 – 15	3 points	3 points
16 – 20	4 points	4 points
21+	5 points	5 points

- 2. One (1) point if the applicant is an IACP member.
- 3. One (1) point if the applicant has been a member of the OACP Board of Directors.
- 4. One (1) point if the applicant has served as a committee chair for the OACP. (Maximum of one point regardless of number of committees)
- 5. One (1) point if the applicant has ever served on a committee of the OACP. (Maximum of one point regardless of number of committees)
- 6. Zero (0) to Twenty-Five (25) points given on the quality of the narrative written.

APPLICATIONS DUE BY MARCH 31ST OF EACH YEAR SCHOLARSHIP WILL BE AWARDED AT THE OACP ANNUAL CONFERENCE AWARDS BANQUET
