Notice of Opening for Police Chief Sunriver Police Department

February 15, 2018

The Sunriver Service District Managing Board is a public safety district providing police and fire protection. The District is seeking a Police Chief for the Sunriver Police Department.

All applicants are invited to become familiar with the unique characteristics of the community. Sunriver is a premier resort community in Central Oregon and a great place to call home. The full-time population is about 1,500 persons and can swell to 20,000 or more during holidays and summer vacation times.

The police department is a full-time, professional accredited police department providing public safety services to the community of Sunriver. A staff of 12 includes the Chief, two Sergeants, eight Officers, an Office Manager, seasonal summer Bike Patrol, and Reserve Officers. There is also a strong contingent of Citizen Patrol volunteers. The department embraces community policing strategies to address quality of life issues with full authority of a certified sworn staff to address criminal acts.

The Chief must possess excellent knowledge, administrative and communication skills. A successful candidate will demonstrate effective leadership in developing positive relationships both internally and externally. The Chief must understand the value of community engagement with a proven record of establishing community partnerships. If you believe you can provide the leadership required for this effort, we welcome your interest in the position.

The position is contractual with the District. The salary range for the last five years has been \$101,000 - \$109,000. Additional benefits include health insurance, life insurance and contribution to a VEBA account. The District is an Oregon PERS employer and pays the employee's 6% retirement contribution. By Oregon statute the Sunriver Service District is PERS exempt, where PERS retirees are able to be employed full time without impacting their existing retirement benefit. The Chief will be provided a take home vehicle. An employment contract will be negotiated with the successful candidate.
